



The map above illustrates the routes that mushers take during the Iditarod. The route changes slightly between even and odd years. Because of the Covid pandemic, the race route this year will look different. Mushers will proceed from Deshka Landing (Willow) to Iditarod where they will turn around and head back to the starting point. Located on the right you can see the exact route the race will follow this year.
